

SCIENTIFIC SUPPORT "SCHOOL PILOT ECONOMIC EDUCATION "

Information on the surveys of pupils at example schools

The school pilot economic education is an initiative of the Stiftung Wirtschaftsbildung (<https://stiftung-wirtschaftsbildung.at>). Starting in fall 2022, selected schools throughout Austria will be supported in the development of a main focus on economic education.

In order to learn from the experiences of the schools, the school pilot is scientifically accompanied by a team of researchers from the **Institute for Advanced Studies (IHS)**, the **University of Duisburg-Essen** and the **Oesterreichische Nationalbank (OeNB)**. Subject of the scientific monitoring is the practical implementation and the expected and unexpected effects of the school pilot. Over a period of four years, several surveys are carried out with pupils as well as with school management and teachers. The Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research has approved this research project.

OBJECTIVES AND TOPICS OF THE SURVEYS

We are interested in how the school pilot affects students – their interests and competences – and how students experience economic education lessons. The following topics are the subject of our analyses:

- Competence to answer important economic questions and to solve tasks,
- interest in and attitudes towards economic issues,
- sense of self-efficacy in dealing with economic challenges in everyday life,
- and assessment of the school pilot and its elements.

WHICH SURVEYS ARE CARRIED OUT?

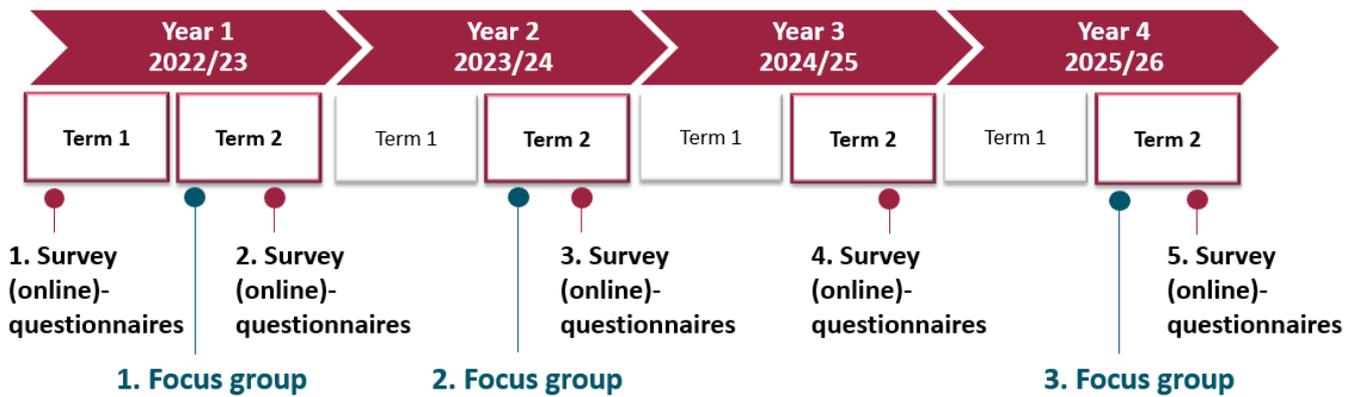
Your school was selected as one of three **example schools**, which we accompany more intensively as part of the school pilot. In addition to the online survey of all students (questionnaires), focus groups with some students as well as interviews with the school management and teachers are also carried out at your school.

▪ **QUESTIONNAIRES (all students)**

During the four-year duration of the school pilot, students are interviewed at five times using **online questionnaires**. Two questionnaires must be completed at the time of the survey; each questionnaire takes up one lesson.

▪ **FOCUS GROUPS (some students)**

A focus group is a **conversation with a group of four to six students**, moderated by a researcher. The aim is to gain insights into the practical implementation of economic education lessons and to learn more about how students experience these lessons. Students are invited to share what seems important to them and what they would like to talk about. A teacher is not present at the interview. The focus group is recorded by means of tape and then written down (transcribed).



DATA PROTECTION AND RESEARCH ETHICS

The data protection and research ethical principles of confidentiality, voluntary consent, anonymity and secure storage of data are important to us in the implementation of our surveys:

- All data and information will be treated **as strictly confidential**. The researchers are obliged to **maintain secrecy** even after the end of the project.
- All data is **safely stored on internal drives**.
- The data will only be used in **anonymous form** for the preparation of publications, research reports and presentations at scientific conferences.
- When publishing results, we make sure that **no conclusions can be drawn about** participating students.

VOLUNTARY CONSENT AS A PREREQUISITE FOR PARTICIPATION

- **Parental consent:** If you as a parent agree to the participation, please fill in the declaration of consent. If no revocation is submitted, this consent remains valid for all our surveys taking place during the four-year period of the school pilot. The signed declaration of consent is collected by the teacher and sent to the Stiftung Wirtschaftsbildung.
- **Consent of students:** In addition, we ask the students for their voluntary consent to participate before each survey. Even during the surveys, students have the opportunity to cancel their participation at any time.

Voluntariness and informed consent are particularly important to us. Therefore, we are happy to take the time to answer questions from your side.
